Kindergarten Registration

February is the system-wide Kindergarten Registration month at the TDSB. If you have a child or know of a child in the <u>Kimberley P.S.</u> district born in 2013 they should begin kindergarten in September, 2017. To attend Junior Kindergarten in September 2017, your child must turn four by December 31, 2017. To attend Senior Kindergarten in September, children must turn five by December 31, 2017.

When registering your child, please bring the following information to Kimberley PS:

- 1. Proof of age (a birth certificate or passport)
- 2. Proof of citizenship

(a birth certificate, passport, or Record of Landing)

3. Proof of address

(<u>two pieces</u> of identification that show your address, such as your telephone bill, driver's licence, bank statement, income tax form, rental or lease agreement)

- 4. Proof of immunization
- 5. Health Card
- 6. Legal Custody Documents (if applicable)

<u>A Forest of Reading:</u> <u>Blue Spruce and Silver Birch</u>



This year students will be participating in the Blue Spruce (K-3) and Silver Birch (4-6) reading programs. These programs provide students with opportunities to read new books by Canadian authors. All grade1-3 students are participating in the program during their library times. Students in grade 4-8 were given the opportunity to join the Silver Birch reading club depending on their grade and interest (fiction or non-fiction). Those students will try to read as many of the 10 books in their category as they can. Those students who read at least 5 books by April will be eligible to vote for their favourite book. Their votes will be counted along with thousands of other student votes from across Ontario and the winning authors will be presented with this year's Forest of Reading awards in May.
