Students in grades 3 and 6 will be writing provincial assessments in Reading, Writing and Mathematics starting the last week of May. These tests come from the provincial Education Quality and Accountability Office and are administered by grade 3 and 6 teachers. This year, the assessments will take place from <a href="Tuesday, May">Tuesday, May</a> 23rd to Friday, June 2nd. Once again, we remind parents that it is important that students attend school every day during the assessment. If possible, please try to arrange appointments outside of the testing period. We appreciate your cooperation.


#### **Support Truth and Reconciliation!**

The Grade 3/4 and Grade 5/6 classes from BAS went to an event at Nathan Phillip's Square called "88 Days Out". It was an event held to kick-off the 2017 Indigenous Games in July. This event was held 88 days before the games because in the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's report, #88 Government Call to Action is about supporting Indigenous Athlete Development. There were a few things happening around Nathan Phillip's Square for us to check out.



When we got to Nathan Phillip's square there were many tents set up around the square. In one of the tents there was a traditional dance going on. We sat and watched the dance for a while. In one of the other tents was a shop that sold beaded bracelets and keychains and other traditional Indigenous crafts and art. There were also places people could try sports like lacrosse, mini golf and basketball. After arriving and visiting the cool attractions, we had lunch. Soon after we had lunch, we went to hear speeches about the up-coming games and the Truth and Reconciliation Act. Many people including a Chief, an Elder and other political figures from both the Provincial and Federal

Levels. Finally, we went to go look at some more dancing and then we headed back to school. It was a great day! Don't forget to support the 2017 Indigenous Games coming up in Toronto this July!


