Student Safety

We remind all parents that student supervision starts at 8:30 am on the pavement at the back of the school. Students must arrive between 8:30 and 8:45 a.m., not before. At entry time there are two designated supervised areas: the apparatus (weather conditions permitting) & the south end of the field and pavement between the portables and the field.

At the end of the school day, there is teacher supervision on the pavement by the portables from 3:30 to 3:45 pm.

Movie Night a Success


