Off to a great start in Toronto public schools



Children born in 2015 are eligible for enrolment in Junior Kindergarten for September 2019. Children born in 2014 are eligible for enrolment in Senior Kindergarten for September 2019. (Children who are already registered at Kimberley P.S. in Junior Kindergarten, DO NOT have to register for Senior Kindergarten.)
