This year, the assessments will take place from Wednesday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> to Wednesday, May 29<sup>th</sup>. Once again, we remind parents that it is important that students attend school every day during the assessment. If possible, please try to arrange appointments outside of the testing period. We appreciate your cooperation.
