Allergy Alert

Orange Shirt Day on September 30, 2022

In 1973, 6-year-old Phyllis Webstad was excited to wear her new orange shirt to her first day of school. Phyllis says of the shirt, "it was so bright and exciting—just like it felt to be going to school!" When she arrived at St. Joseph Mission Residential School, her shirt was taken and never given back. For Phyllis, "the color orange has always reminded me of that and how my feelings didn't matter, how no one cared and how I felt like I was worth nothing. All of us little children were crying and no one cared."

Established in 2013, Orange Shirt Day recognizes the legacy of the Residential Schools System for First Nations, Métis and Inuit families and communities. By wearing orange, we acknowledge the truths of Residential Schools in Canada, we honour Survivors, and we remember the thousands of children that died at these schools, many of them buried in unmarked graves.

On Friday, September 30, 2022 wear orange to participate in Orange Shirt Day.

FIRE DRILLS AND LOCKDOWN DRILLS

In accordance with the Ontario Fire Code, six drills are mandatory each year – three in the fall and three in the spring.

Two Logdown Drills are also mandatory - one in the fall and one before the spring.

Teachers go through the procedures with the students prior to the drills in an age appropriate manner.

Reorganization

Due to large numbers in Kimberley Kindergarten classes, we will now have three full kindergarten classes with 26 or 27 students.

Non-Prescription & Prescription Medication

No staff member is allowed to administer nonprescriptive medication to any student. If a prescription medication is requested to be administered during school hours, a form will be sent home for you to fill in and obtain your doctor's signature. Depending on the age of the child and the circumstances, permission will be given to office staff who will then administer the medication. The medication must have a prescription with dosage, time, date and doctor's name on it and will be stored in the office.
